With everything to play for this year, the Eagles look like a team possessed– their demolition work on UNSW was impressive to say the least– Physick, Oliver and Russell are leading the way.

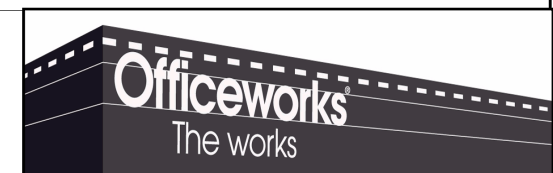

RAMS Record big win over Tasmania

The NSW/ACT Rams have continued their impressive build-up towards the National Under 18 Championships with a convincing 51-point win over the Tasmania Mariners on Saturday night. The home side won the clash at Macquarie University's Roger Sheeran Oval 16.21 (117) to 9.12 (66), with a number of players staking their claim for a place at the national titles in the middle of the year.

Mitch Colvin and late inclusion John Van Meurs each kicked four goals for the Rams as they kicked away from the Mariners late in the match despite being wasteful in front of goal.

Rams coach Danny Stevens was pleased with his side's performance, especially given the quality of the opposition. "It was a really good effort considering we had a couple pull out with injury," Stevens said.

"We had a few of our younger boys that are in our Rising Rams squad come into the side, and not only were they able to fill a hole but they contributed and showed that they were more than comfortable playing at that level.

"So it was a really positive night for us, not only looking forward to what's ahead later this year but for the years ahead."

This year the Rams will play three TAC Cup matches - against the Calder Cannons, Murray Bush-rangers and Bendigo Pioneers - as well as their Challenge Cup and national championship campaigns.

Footage of the Rams' clash with Tasmania will be able to be seen on the FOXTEL AFL Show: NSW/ACT (on Aurora - channel 183), so be sure to watch the program for a glimpse at how the Rams' preparations are going ahead of their Melbourne campaign.

The National Under 18 Championships start on June 23.

Riverview wraps up

The 2007 AFL (NSW/ACT) Under 15 and Under 16 Zone State Trials have concluded, with AFL scouts and staff coming away enthused by the wealth of talent they saw during the week-long camp. AFL (NSW/ACT)'s Talent and Development staff have a tough job ahead of them narrowing down the regional squads to select a state under-16 squad, while they will also choose an under-15 development squad. (Squads will be announced next week)

"This was only the second year that we've run the week-long, live-in camp but already we're starting to see the benefits of the program," AFL (NSW/ACT) Talent and Coach Development Manager Darren Denneman said.

"We've seen a terrific week of footy and, more importantly, I hope everyone that participated will go away from this experience and become better footballers for having been a part of the week."

All 16 AFL clubs were present at Riverview throughout the week. Recruiters could be seen camped in a seat underneath a tree, perched on the hill or sitting in the pavilion at the picturesque school, occasionally taking notes during matches as they searched for players that they hoped could one day be a future star for their own club.

As of May 1, clubs will be able to offer two AFL Scholarships to players that live in NSW's developing market region. Matches at Riverview were played on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, while players were also treated to educational seminars throughout the week - ranging from talks on nutrition to specialist recovery
